We are also pleased to announce that Their Excellencies, Lt Gen The Rt Hon Sir Jerry Mateparae, Governor-General of New Zealand, and Lady Janine Mateparae, have graciously accepted our request to host a reception for our 50th Anniversary celebrations at Government House. This will take place at 4pm on Friday following completion of the AGM. Transport to and from Government house will be provided by buses departing from the Conference venue.

Notes on attendance at Government House

Their Excellencies open Government House to a small number of receptions each year, primarily for organisations that hold vice-regal patronage. We have been very fortunate to secure one of these and naturally attendance is governed by strict protocol.

Costs associated with attendance, including transport, are included in the Full Conference registration fee and for various other classes of registration as set out below.

To be admitted to Government House you will require a personal invitation that will be posted to you by Government House and must be presented at the door on arrival. To receive this you must provide us with your full name and full residential address as part of the registration process. Without this you will not receive an invitation and will not be able to attend. This information must reach us with your registration details, not at some later date. Transport to Government House from the Conference Venue, and return, will be provided by buses that will leave from outside the hotel door.

Government House will advise the Dress Code on your invitation. We expect this to be business attire.

Costs

Your committee has worked to contain registration costs for the Conference and AGM but inevitably there are some increases over 2011. These are caused by the longer time frame and increased costs associated with a larger number of presenters.

To help offset this we have been able to hold accommodation costs at the CO at the same levels as 2011.
